INDUSTRY DEFINITION AND RELATED INDUSTRIES

NAICS 32411: Petroleum Refineries This industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in refining crude petroleum into refined petroleum. Petroleum refining involves one or more of the following activities: (1) fractionation; (2) straight distillation of crude oil; and (3) cracking.
